

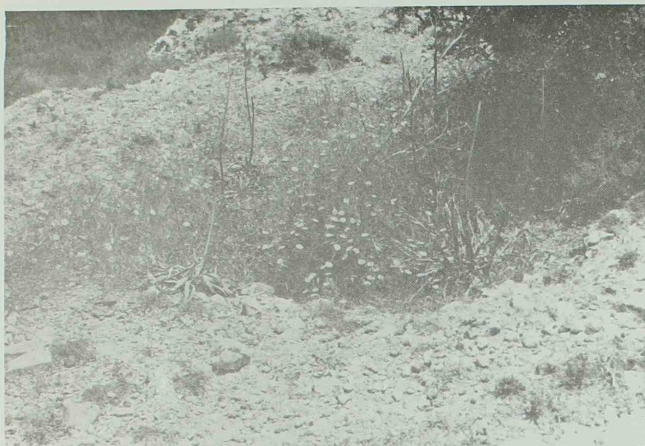


Fig. 1. A tomb excavated by a British expedition in 1897 . 1898.

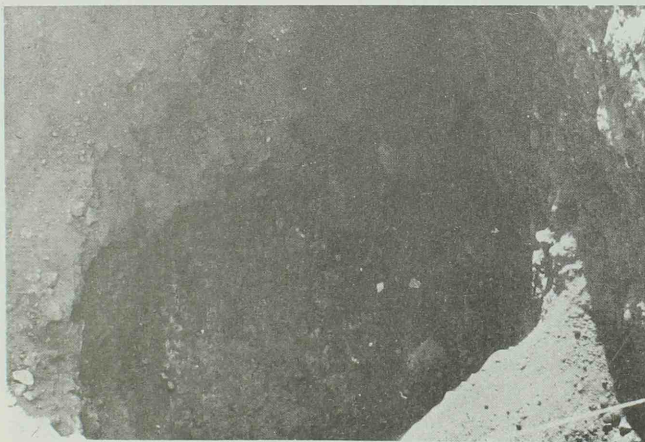


Fig. 4. A pit with copper slag excavated in 1971.

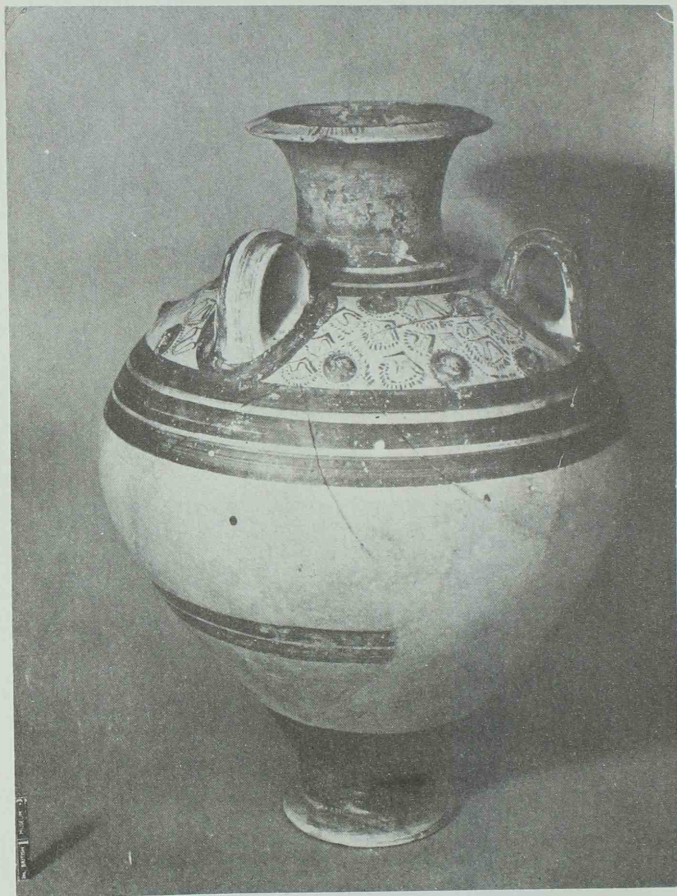


Fig. 2. A Mycenaean III B three handled jar from the British excavations at Hala Sultan

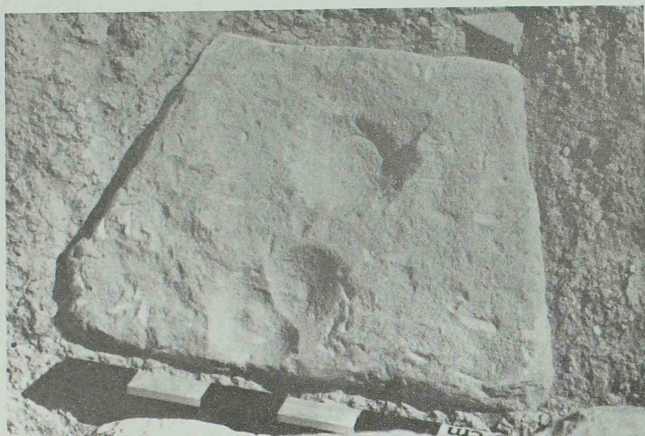


Fig. 7. A stone with two cavities around which crushed purple shells were found.

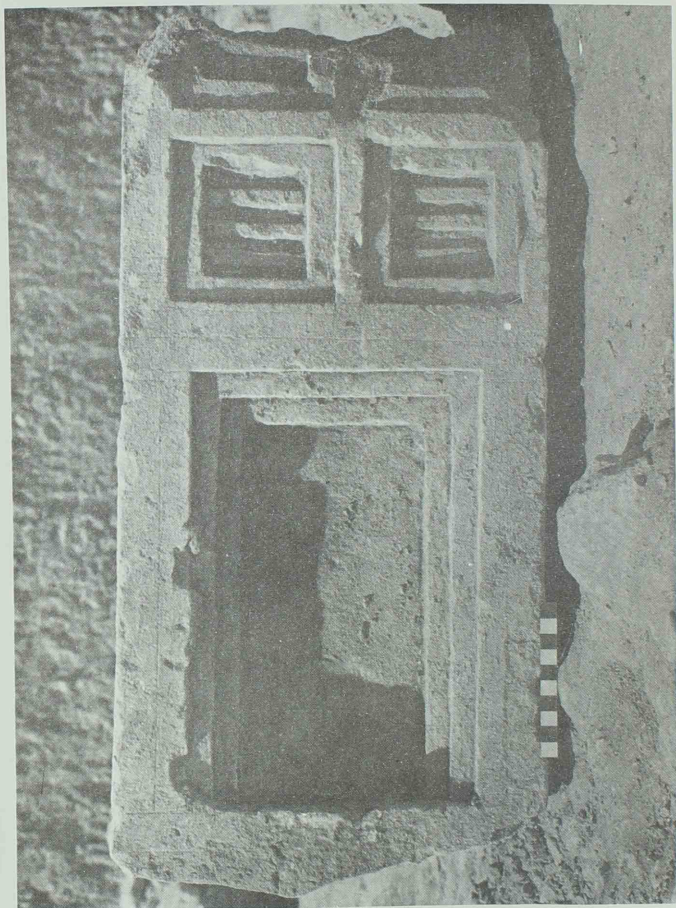


Fig. 8. Model of a building with door and windows.

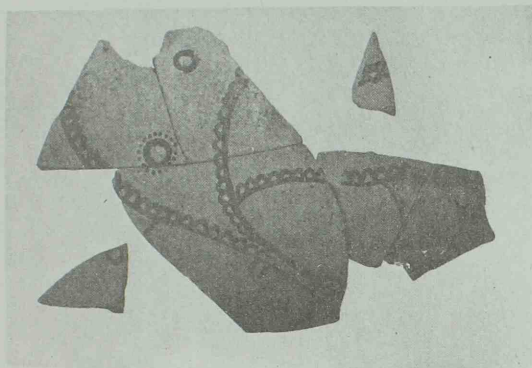


Fig. 9. Impression of a cylindrical seal from a tomb.

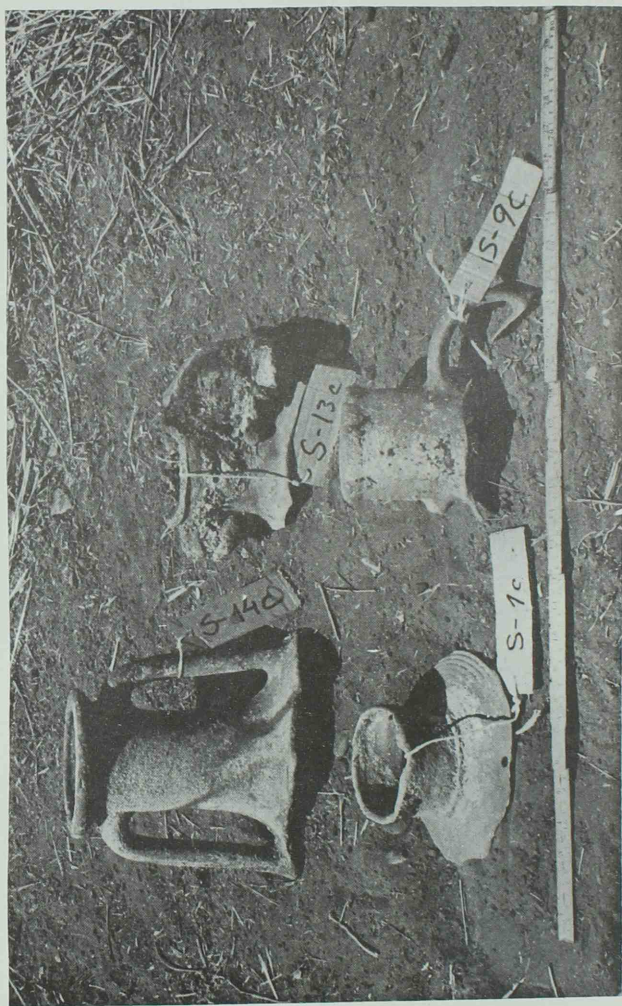


Fig. 11. Finds from the underwater survey.
